Tips for Saving Energy and Money this heating season

Blocking breezes from windows

- Make sure your screens are up and storm windows are down, and your windows are closed.
- Use curtains to block any breezes from windows
- If you find your windows to be drafty, use a plastic window insulation kit. Be sure the storm windows are down first!

Don't use heat you don't need

- Only heat rooms you are using – close doors to rooms that don't need heat
- Turn the temperature down at night or when you are not home
- Instead of turning up the heat, put on more clothing.

Use your heater efficiently

- Don't put the thermostat to 80 when you get home on a cold day – put it on a reasonable temperature and you will notice the unit warming up the room pretty quickly.
- Keep your heater on the economy setting.
- Keep the filters clean by wiping with a dry cloth or using your vacuum cleaner to remove dust.
